



GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTERS

There will be four poster sessions during the congress. Poster sessions 1 and 2 will be held on Thursday 14 May and poster session 3 and 4 on Friday 15 May. Both days between 15.30 and 17.00.

Preparation

- The size of the poster must not exceed **90 cm width x 110 cm height**
- The poster must be fully prepared when you arrive at the congress.
- Do not mount your work on a very heavy cardboard, as this may be too difficult to fix on the wall board. Only adhesives can be used to mount your poster. Adhesives will be available in the poster exhibition area.
- Abstract numbers will be displayed at the top of the relevant poster board. Staff will be available to assist.

Disclosure

We request that all presenters include or attach details of any potential conflict of interests on their poster. You must include details of any company support given, whether in conducting the research, analysing the data, or preparing the presentation.

Presentation

- Each presenter will be allocated on a numbered board.
- Posters should be mounted no later than 8.15 in the morning and dismantled at 17.00.
- Abstracts will be printed in the *Programme Book*
- Two parallel poster sessions conducted on Thursday between 15.30 and 17.00 and two poster sessions conducted on Friday between 15.30 and 17.00.
- Each presentation will be made in English and last two minutes followed by questions to the author. One author per poster will do the presentation.
